- 6th March: Scout & Explorer Leaders

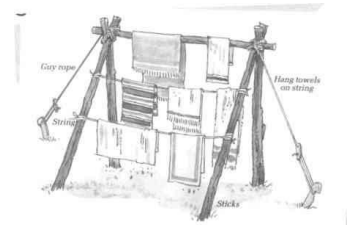
Both of these days will incorporate *Module 18 – Practical Skills* for leaders working toward their Wood Badge or count as ongoing Learning for all other leaders.

The aim of the days are to gain and develop practical skills to assist with delivering the sectional programme. The day will include learning or improving a wide range of practical skills that are appropriate to the section adults are involved in and developing the ability to pass these skills on to our youth members. The course also covers the validation of the module by asking adults to demonstrate the skills they have learnt.

The course will be held at Hargreaves Campsite, the HQ of Ilford East Scout District.

My year started with the annual meeting of the Training Leadership Group, comprising of my team of Deputy CTMs (Julie Leeper, Jackie Geary, Amanda Harrison), Deputy CC for Youth Programme (Peter Seddon), the County Commissioner (Dean Jefferys), and myself. We discussed the successes and challenges of 2010 and what we wanted to achieve in 2011. One of our key focuses for 2011 is to widen the provision that we offer now that we have built strong foundations. This will include:

- Practical Skills Days - 5th & 6th March
- GSLs Conference – 12th March
- Implementation of the new Nights Away Modules 16 & 38
- The role out of the new Safeguarding Training
- Reduction in cost of our First Response Courses to £15
- The role out of the new ADC & DESC Induction Training
- Providing support to ESL (Young Leaders)
- New Activity Training Courses

If you are a GSL reading this column you may be unsure of your role in Training so just to recap... GSLs are responsible for "ensuring that all adults in the Scout Group are appropriately trained". This means ensuring they complete *Getting Started* within 5 months and are working toward their Wood Badge (they have 3 years to achieve this!). The Local Training Manager and Training Advisers are there to support this process. If there are leaders in your Group who are without a Wood Badge and a Training Adviser, (or you aren't sure) then please contact your Local Training Manager. Training Advisers are appointed by the Local Training Manager as part of the Appointments Process.

I look forward to another action packed year in the world of Training in GLNE and thank you in advance to all those involved!

"Pick A Module" (PAM) Evening

"Pick A Module" Evenings provide a flexible way to cover a particular Module that learners need, if they can't attend on one of the preset courses. We have put this provision in place as we no longer offer single Module courses as the demand hasn't been there over the last 3 years. This option therefore still caters for this need, however we now only run a module if requested.

The process for a learner to book is:

Email dctm.md@glne-scouts.org.uk to request to attend one of these nights and what module they would like to cover. Where possible we will arrange for this module to be delivered 1-2-1 with a County Trainer, or possibly in a Small Group if more than 1 person requests the same module.

Please note that not all Modules can be delivered 1-2-1. All Modules still appear on the Training Diary and attending a preset course is the preferred method if possible.

Updated Resources

Nights Away Training has changed.

Module 16 – Introduction to Residential Experiences

This module focuses leaders on understanding the importance of Residential Experiences and the skills they need to support them. This Module is a mandatory Module for the Wood Badge. The Module will be delivered in a 3 hour session.

Module 38 – Skills for Residential Experiences

This module focuses leaders on the skills needed to plan and run a Residential Experiences. This Module is an optional Module for the Wood Badge, however leaders wishing to apply for Nights Away Permit will need the skills / knowledge that are gained from this module before applying for a permit. The Module will be delivered through a Residential Experience Course over a Weekend.

Vacancies within the team...

We have a number of key vacancies within the Adult Training Team;

Local Training Manager (Ilford NorthWest) & Local Training Manager (Hornchurch)

This role will involve managing and supporting the Training / Learning Process in a specific District. Working directly with the Training Advisers and the District Commissioner to ensure that all new adults have access to a Training Adviser to be able to create a Personal Learning Plan. The role also includes ensuring there is the provision of Modules 1,3,4,5,6,7 in the District.

Local Training Manager (Thriftwood)

This role will involve managing and supporting the Training / Learning Process at Thriftwood Scout Campsite. Working in partnership with the Centre Manager to ensure that all members of the Scout Active Support Unit, staff and other volunteers have access to Getting Started & Safeguarding Training.

Assistant County Training Manager (Local Delivery)

Working with the DCTM (Local Training Management), this role involves supporting the delivery of local modules across Districts. Working directly with Local Training Managers supporting them with the delivery of Modules 1,3,4,5,6 and 7. Sharing good practices and running modules when needed.
