### Finding the venue by car:

From the Gants Hill roundabout, take the Woodford Avenue (A1400) following signs to Woodford & Walthamstow.

At the next roundabout, continue along the Woodford Avenue (A1400) following signs to Woodford, Walthamstow & N. Circular.

At the 3<sup>rd</sup> set of traffic lights, turn right into Clayhall Avenue.(note: there is a 7' width restriction on this road.) Take the 5<sup>th</sup> left into Caterham Avenue, then take the 2<sup>nd</sup> left into Felstead Avenue.

Take the 2<sup>nd</sup> left into Hurstleigh Gardens. The 11<sup>th</sup> Ilford North Scout HQ is on your right hand side.

### Parking:

There is ample parking on the roads around the venue. Please check local signs and if you are parking on the road, please park with consideration for residents.

### Finding the venue by public transport:

The nearest Underground station is Barkingside. To walk from the station would take approximately 35 minutes.

From Barkingside Station, walk down Station Road, along Carlton Drive and then turn right into Craven Gardens. At the Fulwell Cross roundabout, follow Fullwell Avenue then take the 8<sup>th</sup> left into Caterham Avenue.

Take the 1<sup>st</sup> right into Basildon Avenue. This will become Felstead Avenue. Follow Felstead Avenue round the left hand bend.

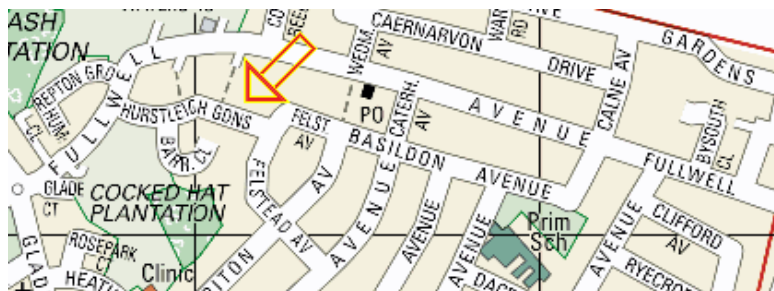
Take the 1<sup>st</sup> right into Hurstleigh Gardens. The 11<sup>th</sup> Ilford North Scout HQ is on your right hand side.

Bus Route 169 from stop S (towards Clayhall/The Glade) will take you as far as The Glade in about 20 mins. Buses run every 10 minutes. From the bus stop on The Glade, turn right as you get off the bus and walk down Fullwell Avenue. Hurstleigh Gardens is the 1<sup>st</sup> main turning on your right. Walk all the way down Hurstleigh Gardens and the 11<sup>th</sup> Ilford North Scout HQ is on your left hand side.
