### Finding the venue by car:

From the A12, Eastern Avenue travelling west (towards London and away from Romford):

- At Little Heath traffic signals turn right into Hainault Road.
- At the mini roundabout, bear left and turn immediately left into Hargreaves Campsite.

From the A12, Eastern Avenue travelling east (away from London and towards Romford):

- At Little Heath traffic signals turn left into Hainault Road.
- At the mini roundabout, bear left and turn immediately left into Hargreaves Campsite.

### Parking:

There is limited parking in front of the venue, accessed by driving through the double gates at the entrance. When large events are planned, further parking may be provided on the field.

There is some parking on the roads around the venue but they are subject to restrictions. Please check local signs and if you are parking on the road, please park with consideration for residents.

### Finding the venue by public transport:

The nearest Underground station is Newbury Park. To walk from the station would take approximately 25 minutes.

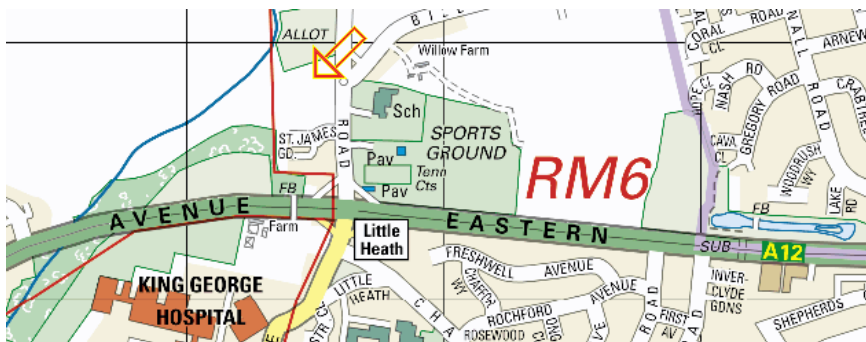
From Newbury Park station, turn left onto the Eastern Avenue and follow it to the Little Heath traffic signals. Turn left into Hainault Road and continue to the mini roundabout. Hargreaves Campsite is on the left just after the mini roundabout.

Bus Routes 296 and 66 from Newbury Park station towards Romford stop at the Little Heath traffic signals.
