Finding the venue by car:

From the A12 Colchester Road travelling east (i.e. away from London and towards Colchester), follow the A12 round the Gallows Corner roundabout, following signs to Harwich, Chelmsford, Stansted Airport and M25. After three quarters of a mile turn right into Gubbins Lane and left at the shops just before the station into Station Road.

From Hornchurch, drive straight across the A127 at Ardleigh Green traffic lights into Squirrels Heath Road. At the little roundabout at the bottom of the hill turn left into Gubbins Lane, drive past the station and turn right into Station Road.

The alley is half way down Station Road on the left between the Bradford & Bingley Building Society and the Rainbow charity shop. The hall is situated on the left at the rear of the alley.

Parking:

Parking is in the Station Car Park, opposite the alleyway. Fees for parking are £2 on a Saturday and £1 on a Sunday (both for all day) which will be refunded at the end of each day.

There is very limited parking in the alley itself and we would strongly advise you to use the Station Car Park as parking in the alley may obstruct other users from nearby offices. If you do need to park in the alley, please note that there are gates at the bottom of the alley which make turning round virtually impossible, so you would have to reverse one way or the other.

Finding the venue by public transport:

Harold Wood Station (on the Liverpool St/Shenfield line) is a couple of minutes walk away as per the instructions above for car users.

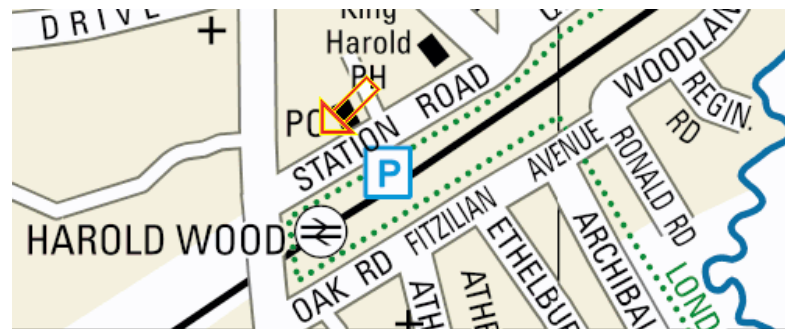
The buses to Harold Wood are the 294 (Havering Park to Noak Hill via Collier Row and Romford), the 496 (Romford Market to Harold Wood Station) and the 256 (Hornchurch to Noak Hill). All the buses have stops a couple of minutes walk from Kingsland Hall as per the instructions above for car users.
